Language requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - For Spanish-conducted courses: A2 level in Spanish language is required by the application deadline. B1 level is recommended by the arrival. - For English-conducted courses: B2 level in English. A test result or a letter from the Home University are admitted.
