

HOW TO REACH THE UNIVERSITY OF LEEDS (UK)



A. Flight from Madrid-Barajas to Liverpool (St. Johns Airport)

- Take a bus up to Liverpool's train station (you can ask at the airport's information point).
- Take a train bound for Leeds (round-trip ticket, valid for a month: 31GBP).
- Take a taxi up to the residence*.
There are also buses (it depends on the hour).

B. Flight from Alicante to Leeds

Take a taxi from Leeds' airport up to the residence*.
There are also buses (it depends on the hour).
